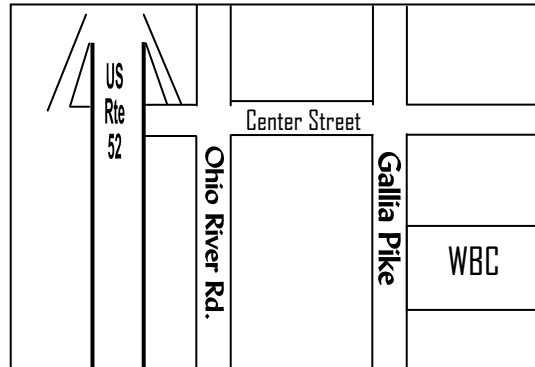

Should I take this course?
