1. The Imperative: *"Let your light shine"*

2. The Explanation:

- a. *"See your good deeds"*

"agathos": good in the sense of morally upright

- "Agathos" should be increasing in a maturing Christian.
- "Agathos" brings pleasure to the One we love.
- "Agathos" give credibility to our testimony.
- "Agathos" rarely compels the lost to follow Christ.

"kalos": good in the sense doing good things

- "Kalos" is what Jesus did
- "Kalos" is a platform for the Gospel
- "Kalos" doesn't like everything but demands a Christ-response
- You cannot be like Jesus without "Kalos"
