**I. We see love’s context (1-2).**

- A. It’s time for Passover.
- B. It’s time for Jesus to go.
- C. It’s time for Jesus to show.
- D. It’s time for Jesus to be betrayed.

**II. We see love’s communication (3-5).**

- A. Jesus’ love is motivated by what He knew (3).
  - 1. He knew what He possessed.
  - 2. He knew where He came from.
  - 3. He knew where He was going.
- B. Jesus’ love is demonstrated by what He did (4-5).
  - 1. He left the meal.
  - 2. He laid aside His garments.
  - 3. He wrapped Himself with a towel.
  - 4. He poured water.
  - 5. He began to wash feet.
  - 6. He dried feet with the towel.

**Implications: What’s the point of the story?**

- 1. We learn about our Savior.
- 2. We learn about our need.
- 3. We learn about the challenges that love creates (6-11).
- 4. We learn about the commission we’ve received (12-17).
