**Community Group Discussion:**

- 4. In verses 24-28 we’re introduced to an intriguing man by the name of Apollos. Why do you think Luke includes him in this story? What do we learn from him about how ministry works?
- 5. Spend some time as a group praying for our missionary team at WBC. Also, ask the Lord of the harvest to raise up and send more laborers from WBC.
