**Community Group Discussion Questions:**

- 5) Throughout our journey in Mark we see the contrast of people, should understand what who Jesus is, don’t get it, and another group of people, who have not earthly reason to understand who Jesus is, see him for who he is. Why is this? What are some practical steps we can take to make sure we are hearing/seeing Jesus accurately?
